



## The AVID Australia Summer Institute 2017

## REGISTRATION HELP GUIDE

1. The registration form for the 2016 AVID Summer Institute can be accessed and downloaded here. The registration form is an Excel file which you must download, update and send back to us. Click on the blue 'Download' button on the top right hand corner of the page (as indicated in the picture below) to save the Excel file to your desktop. 2. Open the Excel file in Excel and fill in the fields in white at the top. Please make sure to provide a contact name and email for your finance officer as this is who we will send your invoice to.


