Upon returning to Australia, participants will be inspired and have practical experience to adapt similar approaches in their own workplaces.

THE TOUR: SUSTAIN AND SCALE CHANGE

This is a rare networking and life-long learning opportunity with colleagues from across Australia and the USA. Participants will engage and network with successful school, system and tertiary leaders, learning of their lived experiences for leading change and hearing about the courage and self-reflection they draw upon to sustain and scale change across their organisations.



Inflexion at the University of Oregon

An exclusive opportunity for Australian participants to work with Inflexion (formerly the Educational Policy Improvement Center (EPIC)) at the University of Oregon. Founded on the work of seminal education researcher Dr David Conley, Inflexion has pioneered the Student Success Model and the Four Keys concept. This in-depth workshop will equip participants with new knowledge and motivation to pursue student success in a holistic and sustainable way.



Nike

The Nike School Innovation Fund has provided \$3.4 million in grants to implement or expand AVID in Oregon schools and districts. As part of a partnership agreement, Nike leaders are paired with 10 local high schools to innovate new ways to address the unique needs of their students. Participants will have the chance to hear from senior Nike executives and see how corporations, innovation and education approaches can align.



AVID demonstration schools

Participants will visit several AVID Demonstration Schools to see how they exemplify outstanding leadership, embody culturally relevant teaching and learning approaches, build relational capacity across the community and invest in strengthening the non-cognitive skills of empathy and a growth mindset. It is a highly sought after honour to be designated as an AVID Demonstration School with less than 1% of AVID's 6000 schools reaching this elite status.



Harvard University with Professor Eric Mazur

Professor Mazur is an award-winning expert in education and science. His influential book, Peer Instruction, explored how science can be taught in an engaging and interactive way. He is recognised worldwide for driving dramatic improvements in students' learning outcomes (in some cases tripling student improvement outcomes). Professor Eric Mazur simultaneously holds three Chairs at Harvard: he is both the Balkanski Professor of Physics and Applied Physics and Chair of the Graduate School of Education.
